

Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between CEPT and UPU

The MOU between CEPT and the UPU has been subject to some revisions from the UPU's side, however after careful review these are considered to be entirely consistent with the proposal on which CEPT members had already voted. The changes are editorial, with the removal of an obligation in respect of external fund raising, and shortening the duration of the agreement to four years.

The MOU (annex) has been signed during the recent CA meeting on 25 April 2013 in Berne (www.cept.org/cept/news/upu-and-cept-strengthen-partnership-on-technical-and-regulatory-issues). Projects within the scope of this MOU are going to be agreed with the International Bureau of the UPU after the summer break this year.
