For the year 2012 Serbia and Cyprus kindly have offered already to host a meeting each.

In the last CERP Plenary on 19-20 May 2011 in Dublin Article 3 of the CERP Rules of Procedure have been amended in so far, that “CERP shall meet in Plenary Meetings at least once a year, up to twice a year if necessary”. Thus – as a minimum – it will be necessary to organize one Plenary meeting each for the forthcoming years 2013 and 2014. In 2015 and 2016 it may – again – be necessary to organize two Plenary meetings due to the UPU congress which is going to take place in 2016.

CERP members therefore are kindly requested to evaluate if and when they may offer to host a Plenary meeting from 2013 onward and to announce this during the Plenary meeting on 27 October 2011 in Montreux.
