About Kristiansand

Kristiansand, which has a population of nearly 80 000, is Norway's fifth largest town and the "capital" of southern Norway.

Kristiansand has the country's second largest harbour and has extensive train, bus, ferry and plane links with the rest of Norway and abroad.

Important details regarding flight bookings

When making your flight booking, please make sure that your destination airport is Kristiansand Kjevik (airport code KRS), as there are other towns in Norway with quite similar names.

Passengers travelling to Oslo from abroad and continuing to Kristiansand should be aware that some budget airlines land at Torp/Sandefjord (TRF) south of Oslo and not Oslo International Airport Gardermoen (OSL). There are no connecting flight between Torp/Sandefjord (TRF) and Kristiansand Kjevik (KRS)

Be aware that in Norway, changing from international to domestic flights will include baggage retrieval and going through clearing customs before rechecking through to your domestic destination.

Make sure that you have sufficient time between flights to do this.

Kristiansand Airport Kjevik (KRS)

Kristiansand Airport Kjevik (KRS) is situated 16km northeast of the city centre. There are between six and ten flights daily from Oslo to Kristiansand (KRS). The airport is connected with the international air traffic network via Copenhagen and Amsterdam.

The airport express bus

The airport express bus runs between the airport and Kristiansand. It stops at most of the hotels and finally at the bus station only 200 metres from Clarion Hotel Ernst, which is the meeting venue. Be aware that buses leave in several directions from the airport. Make sure that you take the correct bus - direction Kristiansand. The bus fare is NOK100 (about 13€), and the trip duration is about 25 minutes.
