PRACTICAL INFORMATION, 37th ECC MEETING June 24th-27th 2014, AARHUS (DENMARK)

Aarhus

Aarhus is the second largest city in Denmark, with approximately 250.000 inhabitants. Aarhus is situated on the east coast of the Peninsular Jutland. Aarhus is one of the oldest cities in Denmark dated back to about year 700. In Aarhus you can find a large number of restaurants, shops, museums, etc. You can find more information about Aarhus at:

Airports

Aarhus Airport is situated around 40 kilometres from Aarhus City. Aarhus Airport has direct flights to Copenhagen (6-8 flight a day). Aarhus also has a few flights directly to London, Gothenburg, Stockholm and Oslo.

From Aarhus Airport you can take a comfortable shuttle bus to the city center. Departure and arrival in Aarhus City takes place in the square Banegårdspladsen – next to the central station, look for route 925X. The departure times of the airport shuttle are not planned until flight departures/arrivals to and from Aarhus airport have been determined. In case the flight is delayed the departure time of the shuttle will be adjusted accordingly. The cost of the shuttle bus is 100 DKK. (Credit cards are accepted on board the bus). Travel time is approximately 50 minutes.

Distance from Banegårdspladsen to Hotel Scandic Aarhus City is approximately 500 metres.

Taxis are also available from the airport. Prices around DKK 650.

Train

From Copenhagen Airport you can also take the train to Aarhus central station. Departure at every hour at XX:30 (direction Aalborg – travel time 3 hours and 9 minutes) and at XX:39 (direction Lindholm – travel time 3 hours and 33 minutes). The price is DKK 375.
