Currently, he is Deputy Director for Radio Spectrum Planning and Management, at the Secretariat of State for Telecommunications and Digital Infrastructures in the Spanish Ministry of Economic Affairs and Digital Transformation **and is representative of the Ministry in the following groups:**

- National Council on Aerospace Safety.
