Subject: Mandate to CEPT on technical conditions regarding the shared use of the 3.8-4.2 GHz frequency band for terrestrial wireless broadband systems providing local-area network connectivity in the Union

Dear Chris,

Considering Article 4(2) of the Radio Spectrum Decision 676/2002/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council, and the favourable opinion (by a written procedure) adopted on 19 November 2021 by the Radio Spectrum Committee in accordance with the advisory procedure under Regulation 182/2011/EU, I am pleased to issue to CEPT the following mandate (attached):

“Mandate to CEPT on technical conditions regarding the shared use of the 3.8-4.2 GHz frequency band for terrestrial wireless broadband systems providing local-area network connectivity in the Union”.

The objective of the mandate is to study the feasibility of using the 3.8-4.2 GHz frequency band by terrestrial wireless broadband systems providing local-area network connectivity in a shared manner with existing uses and to develop, as appropriate, relevant harmonised technical conditions therefor, which are suitable for 5G technology and protect as well as ensure the possibility of future evolution and development of

incumbent spectrum users within the band and in adjacent bands. Upon completion of the mandate, I would appreciate receiving from CEPT the deliverables called for in the mandate, along with an explanatory note on how the tasks have been accomplished.
