How to get to Biel/Bienne

By Air

By train

Bern Airport	1h 20min	Airport Shuttle Bus, then RegioExpress trains	Bern SBB (main station)

Please note that the trains travel once an hour to and from Geneva-Airport, and twice an hour to and from Zürich-Airport.

Biel/Bienne can also be reached by train from Mainz and Paris in about 4½ to 5 hours with 1 up to 3 changes.

Train tickets can be purchased online or in the railway station either at the counter or on ticket machines (cash and credit cards). Please note that return tickets are valid for a maximum of 10 days only for the journeys with distances larger than 116 km. Seat reservations are not needed.

Most of the trains/wagons are equipped with electrical outlets.

By car

There are no visitor parking spaces available at OFCOM, due to construction activities, but there is a public parking at the central railway station in Biel/Bienne which is in close proximity (Bahnhofplatz 4, entrance from Murtenstrasse, www.apcoa.ch/en/parking-in/bielbienne/bahnhof-parking-bielbienne.html).
