Subject: Request to CEPT administrations to provide a web link to public geolocation databases of stations or antennas available at their national websites

Dear Colleagues,

The European Communications Office, tasked by the Working Group Frequency Management (WGFM), kindly requests your assistance in improving the number of national weblinks available on national public geolocation databases for the fixed service in the band 17.7 – 19.7 GHz.

WG FM at their 104th meeting (February 2023 in Berlin) reviewed [ERC Decision \(00\)07](#) on the shared use of the band 17.7-19.7 GHz by the fixed service and Earth stations of the fixed-satellite service (space-to-Earth).

WG FM noted the benefits to satellite operators for the ECO to maintain web-links to national information within the ECC “Topics” pages on geolocation databases covering the Fixed Service as specified in Annex 3 of the Decision. This information is intended to enhance earth stations deployment at 18 GHz. However, WG FM also noted the need to improve the number of national links provided by administrations on the relevant Topic page.

Therefore, WG FM concluded to ask CEPT administrations to provide a current web link to their national web page pointing to publicly available information that meets the requirements of Annex 3 of ERC Decision (00)07.
